

NAPAVINE CITY COUNCIL WORKSHOP MINUTES
August 9, 2017 6:00 P.M.
Napavine City Hall, 407 Birch Ave SW, Napavine, WA

Mayor Sayers called the Fill Permit Workshop to order at 6:00 p.m.

Discussion on the amount of fill necessary to obtain a fill permits with an administrative fee with a suggestion of 0 to 500 cubic yards; Councilor Wood suggested \$40.00 and Councilor Stafford suggested \$20.00. Further discussion on when it's necessary to pull a permit for fill, Bob Bozarth, Woodard Rd stated he was irritated with a \$20.00 admin fee and what business is it of the city if anyone fills on some property. Upon further discussion a fill project of less than 500 cubic yards shall be free with no administrative fee.

Further discussion of when a fill permit is necessary at 500 cubic yards or greater shall require a SEPA study as well as a fee schedule.

Question on old fill permits that were not fulfilled for whatever reason, will they remain valid? If the person has the old permit in hand the city will honor the fill permit.

Discussion on what is considered as land fill and landscaping, upon reviewing some samples those in attendance liked the language of the CleElum Grading, Excavation and Land Filling code 15.30, had great language and addressed the concerns about landscaping to beautify one's property and recommend the city move forward with this language.

Question from Jerry Graham on when do SEPA's expire? He showed a SEPA from 2004 prepared by Todd Mason Engineering and also stated that he had several other SEPA's done on his property.

Workshop adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
