Director Bryan Morris called workshop to order 6:45 pm.

**ITEMS:**

**Shoreline Master Plan Amendment:**

- Devin Jackson from Jackson Civil Engineering presented information on the Shoreline Master Plan Amendment, he will be updating the plan which was last updated in 2018.
- He plans to add mitigation to zone the area as commercial allowing an RV Park.

Paster Scott Collins

- Asked if an RV Park could be placed within 50 feet of the shoreline.
- Can they add dirt to the water's edge and bring in bark to make trails?

Director Morris

- Explained the road would need to be behind the setback of 150 feet, the lodge, tent sites or deck can be closer to the water. Imagine the waters edge you could have tent sites and picnic tables with barbecue areas. 150 feet would be the road or parking area.

Paster Kyle Rasmussen

- What is the uphill battle? We will need to bring in the road no more than 150 feet and lodge, RV sites and tent sites?

Jerry Graham

- Brought to everyone's attention the yellow highlighted area on the map of the fishhook is the highest spot in that location. How can they say that is wetland?

Devin Jackson thanked everyone for their input to the workshop and advised they planned to have another workshop in a month or so for final review.
